Security through Surveillance (STS) is an initiative in which the police department partners with businesses and homeowners to prevent and solve crime through the use of surveillance technology. When a crime occurs, a resident or business may unknowingly record the crime, possible suspects, or an escape route the criminals used. If private surveillance cameras are not registered, the information captured is often lost to law enforcement personnel. Law enforcement personnel will not have live access to surveillance cameras rather they will be aware of where cameras are located in the event footage is needed for an investigation.
