Attend community property tour about residential herbicide damage hosted by Patsy Hirsch & Sue Styer. Below is their communication and description of the event:

'We have begun another season of herbicide drift damage to our property, throughout Elgin, surrounding communities and beyond. I am reaching out to you to let you know that we are partnering with Illinois PIRG & Environment Illinois to host a tour of our property to make more people aware of herbicide damage, again using our property as an example. Sue Styer continues to help me with this problem. We are inviting you to attend, you'll see how different herbicide damage looks in the spring (much different than what you saw last August/September) and to represent your group/committees/organizations/elected/appointed position.'

We are inviting reporters, members of the public, impacted individuals, state and local elected officials, and representatives from various conservation and health organizations there. State Representative Ann Moeller has agreed to attend and will share information about HB 4363 Dicamba Ban. The tour will be during National Pollinator Week (since herbicide damage affects pollinators), on Thursday, June 23rd 1pm at 12N002 Hidden Hill Trail, Elgin, with Friday, June 24th as the rain date.
