PICNIC SHELTER RULES

PARK RULES/REGULATIONS:

- No alcohol is allowed in any of the parks.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times and cleaned up after.
- PARK HOURS ARE FROM DAWN TO DUSK.
- No fireworks or firearms are allowed.
- No horses or ponies are allowed in the park unless authorized.
- No moonwalks, tents, canopies or any devices which are staked down are allowed in any of the parks.
- No dunk tanks, cash booths, generators, live music or carnival games are allowed in our parks. *(Any event using these items needs a special events permit - contact Kate O'Leary at 847-931-6770).*
- Do not disturb or interfere with birds or animals, plants, shrubs, fences or benches.
- Do not write on or deface in any manner any property or thing in the park.
- Do not paste or affix any posters in or around the park.
- Do not drive in excess of 15 miles per hour within the park and do not park any vehicle except in designated areas.
- No fires allowed except in designated areas. All charcoal fires must be contained in standard barbecue equipment and cinders removed from park by lessee.
- Do not litter, do not throw stones or rubbish nor bathe in any pond or stream.
- Do not play football, baseball or any other game except in designated areas.
- Do not hit golf balls except in designated area.

SOUND AMPLIFICATION ORDINANCE/GUIDELINES:

- The operation of sound amplifying equipment shall occur:
 - Sundays - Thursdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
 - Fridays & Saturdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m.
- No person shall operate or permit operation of any sound amplification device or system from any property line within the city which can be heard from a distance of 75 (seventy-five) feet or more from any property line of such residential property during nighttime hours or which can be heard from 150 (one hundred fifty) feet or more from the property line of any such residential property during daytime hours.
- No sound amplifying equipment shall be operated within 200 (two hundred) feet of churches, schools, or hospitals.
- Operation of sound amplifying equipment shall be restricted to 1 (one) event per 300 (three hundred) feet of simultaneous use.
- Although no permit is issued for music, if complaints of any type are received, the Police Department is obligated to respond and enforce City Ordinances.
