What can you expect to learn?

You will be exposed to many law enforcement skills that include:

- Building clearing
- CPR certification
- Crime prevention
- Hostage negotiations
- Patrol procedures
- Real police training
- Simulation training
- Traffic stops
- Traffic direction
- Report writing

What does an Explorer do?

In return for the training that is provided, each Explorer is asked to perform 8-10 hours of service each month. The service hours vary based on details that are scheduled and can be inclusive of:
